**NOTE:** Immediate (within 1-hr) verbal notification is required by the LA State Police if a facility experiences an unauthorized release of 100-lbs (or greater) within any 24-hour period of a flammable substance from a vessel under pressure or from a refrigerated vessel/unit. The 1-hr reporting requirement would also apply to an unauthorized release event from a piece of equipment that is not under pressure or operates under 'extremely low' pressure (i.e. storage tank, vent scrubber, etc.), IF that release meets or exceeds 5000 lbs. of a flammable material within any 24-hour period. Generally speaking, 100 lbs. of a flammable gas equates to approximately 2-MSCF and 5000 lbs. of a flammable gas equates to anywhere from 60 to 100 MSCF of gas (dependent on gas composition).
